## Knowlton School of Architecture Students Reimagine the Future of Don Scott Field

This spring, architecture students were tasked with developing a master plan and schematic designs for select buildings at the Ohio State University Airport under the instruction of Knowlton School Professor Robert Livesey.

Students began the design process by researching general aviation airports to gain an understanding of the relationships between airside and landside, how user groups interact, and how airports are secured. This knowledge then was translated into a master plan for the south section of the airport and schematic designs for a terminal and educational facilities for the Ohio State Flight Education Program, a Maintenance Technology Program, a Maintenance, Repair, and Overhaul (MRO) facility, a series of general aviation T-hangars, and a series of corporate clear-span hangars.

The studio culminated with a project review featuring Doug Hammon, the airport director, and a representative of Moody Nolan, the firm chosen to redesign the new terminal, along with Knowlton professors and visiting architects.
